# **CNA Biological**

Benwood will educate via website on fecal and the use (minimization) of salt for deicing, and resulting chlorides in streams to address the biological impairment. Through education for fecal and salt use, the City expects to control the biological impairment

### Iron:

Iron impairments will be controlled through the construction ordinance with Erosion and ediment Controls (ESC). Iron in sediments will be controlled or mitigated by:

- 1. Giving site operators specific information/requirements (ESC) when applying for permits
- 2. Performing inspections of the construction site

# Fecal Coliform

- 1. Educate residents and businesses on pet waste on website.
  - By educating our citizens and businesses, we expect to control or decrease fecal contamination to impaired streams
- 2. Establish a hot-line (phone number) on website for reporting sewage leaks/sewage odors.
  - Citizens and businesses can report any illicit discharges on our hotline, and the city can respond to mitigate discharges, thereby controlling or reducing fecal contamination to impaired waters. Hotline calls will validate that citizens are aware of illicit discharges (fecal, sedimentation-Fe).
- 3. Perform inspections for illicit connections, illicit discharges, and improper disposal into the separate storm sewer system.
  - Inspections of the stormwater system may catch discharges in their incipient stage, or failing infrastructure that can be repaired

- 121. Site plan reviews are made to assist developers in reducing footprints to assist in reducing the amount of impervious services.
- 122. When projects are set to occur in ecologically sensitive areas, the City will direct the developers and their engineers to the "Natural Stream Design" methods in accordance with the U.S. army Corps of Engineers practices.
- 123. During site plan reviews, the City requires that all new developments and redevelopments to provide permanent BMPs to accomplish stormwater management.
- 124. During site plan reviews, the City requires that all new developments and redevelopments to provide permanent BMPs to accomplish stormwater management.
- During site plan reviews, City staff observes whether trees are anticipated to be reviewed. If so, a request will be made of the developer and engineer to install trees on the site to provide a net zero impact on tree population.
- 126. During site plan reviews, City staff observes whether the site appears to have native soils. If so, the developer and engineer will be advised to devise a plan to protect these native soils.
